

## KID KWILTS 2020 BLOCK DRIVE – Disappearing Nine Patch Base

The Kids' Bee invites you to join us in making these simple blocks.

**Please make each block as follows –**

Place the single WHITE block in the center, with four matching colors in the outer four corners, and a second set of four bright colors surrounding the white center block.

If you received a kit, squares are  $4\frac{1}{2}$ " , and the final block is  $12\frac{1}{2}$ " as sewn. Follow these same guidelines if you are using your own fabric.

To assemble, use a SCANT  $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam. When three squares are sewn together, measure the width of the center block in the row.

It should be 4" wide between the seams and the three squares sewn in a row should be  $12\frac{1}{2}$ ". The finished block will be  $12\frac{1}{2}$ ' as sewn.

Because many hands will work on the blocks, we ask that the blocks measure  $12\frac{1}{2}$ " as sewn. Please adjust as needed.
