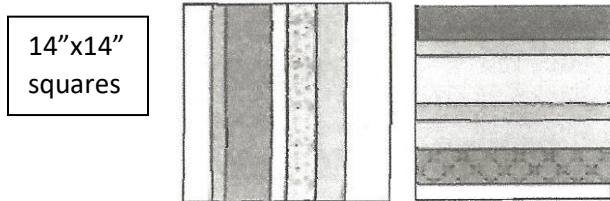


KID KWILTS 2022 BLOCK DRIVE – Open Windows

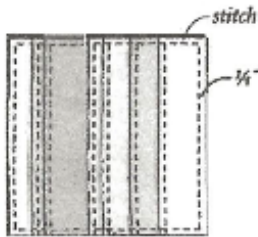
The Kids' Bee invites you to join us in making these simple blocks.

Please make each block as follows –

Using a variety of black and white fabrics, make two 14" squares using about 9-10 strips of various widths in each square. Include *at least* 1 solid or tone-on-tone solid strip in each square; you can use up to 2 colored strips in each square, if desired. Press carefully and keep seams straight. If necessary, trim the block to 14"x14".

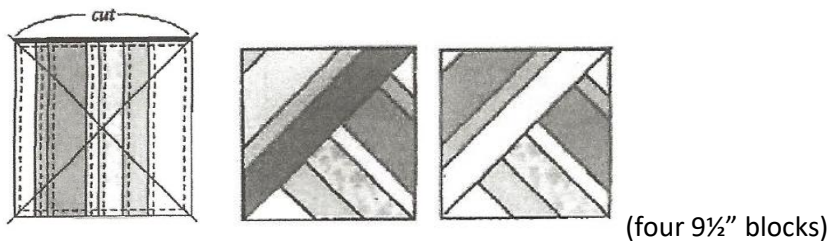


Lay the two squares right sides together with one block's strips vertical, the other block's horizontal. Pin each side to keep it from slipping. Sew $\frac{1}{4}$ " around the entire square sandwich.



Keeping 1 square horizontal and 1 vertical, lay the 2nd right side down on top of the 1st square.

Carefully cut the 2 sewn squares in half diagonally twice. Unfold the four cut triangles to reveal 4 pieced $9\frac{1}{2}$ " blocks.



Press and handle carefully, as these four blocks have bias edges.

Turn your finished blocks into Kids' Bee for assembly into donation quilts.
