



Happy New Year! It's time to plan our 2025 guild quilt retreats. We have a fun time at these retreats; it's a perfect time to meet new friends and work on your quilt projects. Also a good time to get help with your projects too.

Get out your calendars and make your plans. Only one form is needed per year, but it must include any food allergies or special needs. Your emergency contact person and their phone number are very important. Don't forget to include anyone that you would like to sit by or room with; we will try to accommodate all requests. (Please read everything.) Once you've decided which retreats you want to attend fill out the form and a check made out to Denton Quilt Guild, then mail it to:

#### DAY RETREATS: Spring and Summer

Held at Box Car's Event Center. It is a large room, but seating is limited so be sure to register early. Our day will start at 9:00 am and end at 7:00 pm. Lunch and dinner will be served, plus games and prizes. An email will be sent out just before the retreat with the seating chart and any last minute information.

April 3-5 - The fee for all 3 days is \$140; for 2 days \$105; for 1 day \$55.

August 14-16 - The fee for all 3 days is \$140; for 2 days \$105; for 1 day \$55.

#### **OVERNIGHT RETREAT:** Fall

Held at Box Car's Maxine's Manor. There are only 24 beds available so sign up early. Check in is noon Thursday and check out is noon Sunday. Meals are provided from dinner Thursday to breakfast Sunday. Games and prizes are always on the schedule. An email will be sent out just before the retreat with the seating chart, room chart, and any last minute information. (If you need a payment plan, please email me before writing your check and I will send you the payment plan information.)

November 13-16 – The fee for the entire retreat is \$320 (less days are not available).

#### ALL RETREATS:

All fees must be paid in full by 30 days prior to the event. After paid in full dates the fees are nonrefundable. If your plans change you may sell your spot to another quilter or contact Sherry to see if there is a waiting list.




### **Continuing Education**
